Body Cream for Dry Skin

With Aloe Vera and Vitamins

The components of the fatty phase a) are melted in the ointment mixer at 80 – 90 °C; then the phase b) is added portion by portion at the same temperature by stirring quickly and then emulsified. The phase c) is added at approx. 40 °C or according to the producer's instructions. Finally we recommend to homogenise the preparation. By using modern ointment mixers the product can be made according to the so called "hot-cold-procedure".
